

Recently I got selected for the Young Scientist Programme (YUVIKA) 2023 organised by the prestigious Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO). After competing with around 10-12 lakhs of students I finally made my place in the top 352 students across India. The programme was organised in 7 ISRO centers out of which I was allotted the Indian Institute of Remote Sensing (IIRS), Dehradun. My journey to Dehradun started on May 14, 2023 which also made me a step closer to my dream. I reached there and got my hostel room where I had to spend the next two weeks. The programme started on May 15 with the inaugural ceremony and ended on May 26, 2023 with the valedictory. A typical day at IIRS started with yoga at 6 am and then lectures and practicals from 9 am to 5 pm. Where we studied about space and rocket science. In the practicals we made a water rocket, a model rocket, a rover and also tracked a NASA satellite (NOAA - 15) and recieved signals from it. After 5 pm we had co-curricular activities which included sports and music. Apart from this we did some exceptional activities like bird watching and stargazing. On weekends we had visits to various institutes like Indian Military Academy(IMA), Forest Research Institute(FRI), Vigyan Dham, and Rajaji Tiger Reserve. We had interactive sessions with the most experienced scientists of ISRO including Dr. S. Somnath(Chairman ISRO), Dr. N. Sudheer Kumar (Director CBPO) and Dr. R. P. Singh (Director IIRS). And finally how can I miss talking about the late night fun with the new friends I made at IIRS. On the last day we had a cultural programme for which we had been practicing for days. The cultural programme and then the valedictory was enough to bring tears to the eyes of all the 47 young scientists, after all we had made a lot of memories together. I still remember how hard it was to just say hello to a new friend on the first day but now we couldn't say goodbye. Along with ISRO's merchandise, I came back with a lot of knowledge, memories and experiences.
