

NOTHING SUCCEEDS LIKE SUCCESS-SO MAKE IT A HABIT



MANAGEMENT ADDRESSING TO THE PARENTS' FAQs



Dear parent/guardian,

As you are aware, we are facing the second, and more devastating, wave of the COVID-19 pandemic, which is expected to involve many more lockdowns and restrictions. There would be times when we would be shuffling between online and offline mode of learning. In this regard we, at Little Scholars, have always been a step ahead and will continue to do so.

The media/social media plays a vital role in the dissemination of information, specially, with respect to the latest government guidelines and orders, which, on one hand, is good to keep us updated but, at times this information, specially coming from unconfirmed social media platforms may be factually incorrect/Misinterpreted or conjectures based on hearsay. To avoid any miscommunication, we would like to keep you updated with the working of the school and the latest Government Orders (G.O.) issued to us from time to time.

Some of the frequently asked questions by guardians lately are as under

1. Will the school run in online mode all year round?

Ans: As per the latest G.O., classes shall be conducted in online mode till further orders. Fresh guidelines/instruction regarding the same are likely to be issued around the 3rd of May 2021.

2. The state secretary states that students shall be charged only tuition fees?

Ans: The orders regarding tuition fees has been issued on the 25th of April 2021, prior to which the school was instructed to charge complete fees as per offline classes

(Classes 6 to 10 & 12) as all facilities were being made available.

So, since bills are generated monthly, students have been charged complete fees for the month of April where offline classes were conducted, whereas for the month of May and beyond, they would be charged only tuition fee (or as per the instructions from the Government). The ERP is an added resource important for our communication, attendance, online payment gateway, progress report, etc.

3. What is the billing cycle and will we face penalty?

Ans: Billing cycle shall be monthly through the pandemic and we shall not be charging any penalty for late fees. However, we do request all the parents to pay the due amount in time to facilitate the timely payment of salaries.

4. How do we know the progress of our ward?

Ans: In the VISION 2021-22 (current year), two major changes have been incorporated for the benefit of our students.

- **a.** Creating a Digital Footprint of each student to asses and promote learning and overall development.
- **b.** Hybrid System of pedagogy through Experiential Learning to cater to the Skills Outlook for the future.

We, at Little Scholars would like to assure you that we will ensure the best possible growth for your ward. We would also like to clarify that, although there will be no unjustified expenses charged, nonetheless, if there are any discrepancies found, the same shall be reimbursed at the earliest.
